RULES AND REGULATIONS – DEMOCROSS

IMPORTANT: Each driver and mechanic must sign in at registration desk the day of show and have their cars inspected solely to determine compliance with those rules (and not for purpose of determining safety of car or participant) at least 90 minutes prior to show time or he will be ineligible to run! NO REFUNDS!

DRIVER MUST ATTEND DRIVERS' MEETING PRIOR TO DEMOLITION DERBY OR DRIVER WILL BE DISQUALIFIED AND CAR MUST BE THROUGH TECH

I have read the rules and acknowledge to have received a copy of same and agree that the decision of the Judges is final. I agree to participate at my own risk absolutely. It is a condition of my participation in the contest that I sign a further release of liability in the form to be supplied by Thrill Show Productions Inc. and I agree to sign such a release.

SPECIAL NOTICE: NO ALCOHOL OR DRUGS ALLOWED IN ANY RESTRICTED (PIT, HOLDING OR PERFORMING) AREA. ANY VIOLATIONS WILL RESULT IN DISQUALIFICATION OF CAR, DRIVER AND CREW. NO REFUNDS !!!

The Thrill Show Productions Inc. Demolition Derby is promoted as an unusual spectator attraction.

DRIVERS and MECHANICS are subject to and must obey the following rules and regulations which are set up by the promoter and the track where this event is being held:

- 1. Each DRIVER/MECHANIC must be of legal age (17 years old). Parental and Minor waivers must be signed for 17 year olds. Proof of Age must be presented when signing in.
2. Each driver must fill out a registration form. All drivers must supply their own cars. ONLY ONE REGISTRATION PER PERSON. Drivers should have proof of ownership. Cars cannot be double entered.
3. Thrill Show Productions Inc. or promoter reserves the right to approve or reject any and all entries.
4. Only drivers and mechanics who sign the release sheet will be permitted in the pit area or on the track. Driver and one (1) pit person receive free pit passes upon registration of car on day of show.
5. Contestants of the Thrill Show Productions Inc. Demolition Derby are not employees of the track, fair association or the promoter of the Thrill Show Productions Inc. Demolition Derby.
6. Thrill Show Productions Inc., the promoter, track owner or fair association will not be held responsible for any cars, parts or personal property before, during and after the show. NO PHOTOCOPYING OF REGISTRATION FORMS. All forms are to be filled in and signed by driver and registration fee paid at time of entry. Any driver changes must be approved by Thrill Show Productions Inc.

REGISTRATION PROCEDURE – REGISTRATION FORMS

Registration must be made in the name of the driver who will actually participate in the event. If the driver who is entered cannot participate, the DRIVER DOES NOT have the right to resell or designate the registration to someone else. At the discretion of Thrill Show Productions and/or the Fair Board, the registration may be sold back to the seller, who will in turn sell it to the next person on its waiting list. This option will become available only after all registrations are completely sold out.

Type of Car – DO NOT REMOVE VIN #

- 1. Any 4 or 6 cylinder hardtop automobile or station wagon with a wheelbase of 106.9" or less.
2. No trucks, convertibles, jeeps, vans, hearses, limousines, checker cabs or cars with four-wheel drive systems.
3. Cars previously run in demos may be considered too battered and unsafe, resulting in disqualification.

RUNNING

- a. Risk: Demolition derbies are hazardous and high-risk sports; therefore, anyone with a health condition, i.e., concussion, heart problems etc. or who is pregnant should not compete.
b. Disqualification: 1. Open Door 2. Fires 3. Unsafe vehicle 4. Non-working fire extinguisher 5. Special situation deemed necessary by official.
c. Personal Protective Equipment (PPE): Flame retardant racing apparel highly recommended. Racing suit, racing or work boots, neck brace, and gloves. Sport padding can also be used in addition to protective apparel. NO EXPOSED SKIN
d. Motor Sports helmets are mandatory – with most recent safety certification recommended. Goggles or face shields should be used.
e. Working Driver's seatbelt is mandatory.
f. BRAKES – VEHICLES MUST HAVE DEPENDABLE BRAKES AND MUST BE WORKING PROPERLY BEFORE ENTERING PEN AT ALL TIMES. All boundaries must be observed
g. NO DRINKING OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ON TRACK, EMERGENCY VEHICLE AREA OR IN THE PIT AREA. Any driver or pit person under the influence of alcohol or drugs will be immediately disqualified and removed from the grounds. This will be strictly enforced.
h. Competitive aggressive hits! Sandbaggers will be disqualified!
i. All cars are to be removed from the fairgrounds or racetrack immediately following the show.
j. Additional safety regulations may be imposed, depending on track and conditions.
k. ALL DECISIONS OF THE OFFICIAL ARE FINAL.

NO CHANGES OR ALTERATIONS OF RULES MAY BE MADE EXCEPT BY THRILL SHOW PRODUCTIONS INC.

PREPARATION OF CAR – REMOVE OR CONVERT THE FOLLOWING PRIOR TO ARRIVING AT FAIRGROUNDS OR TRACK

1. RIDING ON CAR	Insurance Regulation: No person riding on outside of cars at anytime
2. TRIM & MIRRORS	All must be removed from the vehicle.
3. GLASS/AIRBAGS	All windows, mirrors, airbags & trim, must be removed prior to derby event.
4. DOORS, NUMBERS & PAINT COLOURS	Driver & Passenger doors must be PAINTED WHITE. An optional roof number plate may be securely installed. NO painting of number on doors unless number registered with TSPI office (see website for details).
5. FIRE EXTINGUISHER	Must be within reach of the driver, must work and have a working gauge.
6. BATTERY	Recommend one 12 volt car battery be moved to front passenger floor board and securely fastened in a box/container clear of all fuel sources. Following inspection it must be covered with a non-flammable shield, OR can be left in original location & covered with a non-flammable shield.
7. GAS TANK	Can be left in original location. If has been moved, the tank must be a steel marine tank, custom steel fuel tank, or certified racing fuel cell. No plastic tanks. All tanks must be securely fastened down (bolted) in the middle of the back seat area. Tank must be covered with a non-flammable material after inspection. Maximum 3 gallons gas. Referee has final decision.
8. FUEL LINES	If gas tank is relocated, all fuel lines must have leak proof fitting with steel or rubber lines. No exceptions.
9. ELECTRIC FUEL PUMP	If gas tank has been relocated to Driver's compartment, must have a safety shut off switch (punch button), marked in red located on roof in center of the windshield area for officials use.
10. FUEL SYSTEM	If fuel system has been moved, electric fuel pump must be isolated with a non-flammable material covering lines, tank & pump. Non-flammable covering may be fire resistant blanket or air bag material.
11. HOOD & TRUNK	A 12" opening must be cut in hood over carburetor (not over fan). Hood must be fastened down in maximum of 6 places with seat belt strapping, wire or 1/4" chain only. Following inspection one wire may be ran from center of hood to bumper as the 6 th spot. Trunk/tailgate to be fastened down in same way or may be welded using 6 – 3" square plates. If trunk is welded a 16" square hole must be cut in top of trunk for officials' inspection. Hoods are mandatory at the beginning of the derby but if has become too damaged for feature heat, the hood & motor fan must be removed before entering the pen.
12. DOOR FASTENING	Driver's door may be welded solid. All other doors can be fastened shut with wire, straps, 1/4" chains or spot-welded 1" every 12" or 6 – 3" square plates welded on per door. Solid driver's door window screens are not recommended.
13. BRACING	Outside of car may have a 12" X 48" X 1/4" max steel plate applied to driver & passenger doors, bolted in 4 locations (with a maximum 1/2" through bolt) & spot welded 1" every 12". Bevel should not exceed 20°. NO "C" CHANNEL OR ANGLE IRON.
14. ROLL CAGE	INSIDE CAR ONLY. Floor to roof bar behind driver's seat, HIGHLY RECOMMENDED.
15. WINDSHIELD SPACE	Strong steel construction-type wire mesh is recommended for left front windshield only. One (1) strong upright steel, chain or iron bar must be bolted in windshield space. A or H style protection is also allowed.
16. BUMPERS	Appropriately sized car bumper only, to be used. May be mashed in so not to catch on other cars. Bumpers can not be cut, and cannot extend further than the width of the car. No loading of bumpers. Officials may request a hole be made in bumper for inspection. Trailer hitches must be removed
17. RADIATOR	Must be flushed of anti-freeze and replaced with water only. Overflows must point straight down or positioned so not to harm other drivers & spectators.
18. SUSPENSION	Movement must occur.
19. HEADERS	Headers are not required. If present, must be secure, must point upwards and not at other drivers/spectators. Must be a reasonable length or will be asked to be cut or removed. Official's discretion.
20. TIRES	Hubcaps & wheel weights must be removed. Maximum 16" D.O.T. Tires must be low aggression. No forklift tires or solid fill tires. All tires must be filled with air only. Tires may be doubled. No split rims. No screwing tires to rim or studding. All wheel weights must be removed and no welding stem protections. Carry spare 16" D.O.T. mud tires in case track conditions warrant. Referee's discretion.
