RULES AND REGULATIONS – MINIVANS

IMPORTANT: Each driver and mechanic must sign in at registration desk the day of show and have their cars inspected solely to determine compliance with those rules (and not for purpose of determining safety of car or participant) at least 90 minutes prior to show time or he will be ineligible to run! NO REFUNDS!

DRIVER MUST ATTEND DRIVERS' MEETING PRIOR TO DEMOLITION DERBY OR DRIVER WILL BE DISQUALIFIED AND CAR MUST BE THROUGH TECH

I have read the rules and acknowledge to have received a copy of same and agree that the decision of the Judges is final. I agree to participate at my own risk absolutely. It is a condition of my participation in the contest that I sign a further release of liability in the form to be supplied by Thrill Show Productions Inc. and I agree to sign such a release.

SPECIAL NOTICE: NO ALCOHOL OR DRUGS ALLOWED IN ANY RESTRICTED (PIT, HOLDING OR PERFORMING) AREA. ANY VIOLATIONS WILL RESULT IN DISQUALIFICATION OF CAR, DRIVER AND CREW. NO REFUNDS !!!

The Thrill Show Productions Inc. Demolition Derby is promoted as an unusual spectator attraction.

DRIVERS and MECHANICS are subject to and must obey the following rules and regulations which are set up by the promoter and the track where this event is being held:

- 1. Each DRIVER/MECHANIC must be of legal age (17 years old). Parental and Minor waivers must be signed for 17 year olds. Proof of Age must be presented when signing in.
2. Each driver must fill out a registration form. All drivers must supply their own cars. ONLY ONE REGISTRATION PER PERSON. Drivers should have proof of ownership. Cars cannot be double entered.
3. Thrill Show Productions Inc. or promoter reserves the right to approve or reject any and all entries.
4. Only drivers and mechanics who sign the release sheet will be permitted in the pit area or on the track. Driver and one (1) pit person receive free pit passes upon registration of car on day of show.
5. Contestants of the Thrill Show Productions Inc. Demolition Derby are not employees of the track, fair association or the promoter of the Thrill Show Productions Inc. Demolition Derby.
6. Thrill Show Productions Inc., the promoter, track owner or fair association will not be held responsible for any cars, parts or personal property before, during and after the show. NO PHOTOCOPYING OF REGISTRATION FORMS. All forms are to be filled in and signed by driver and registration fee paid at time of entry. Any driver changes must be approved by Thrill Show Productions Inc.

REGISTRATION PROCEDURE – REGISTRATION FORMS

Registration must be made in the name of the driver who will actually participate in the event.

If the driver who is entered cannot participate, the DRIVER DOES NOT have the right to resell or designate the registration to someone else.

At the discretion of Thrill Show Productions and/or the Fair Board, the registration may be sold back to the seller, who will in turn sell it to the next person on its waiting list.

This option will become available only after all registrations are completely sold out.

Type of Car – DO NOT REMOVE VIN #

- 1. Any Minivan without a frame (Magic Wagon, Caravan, Windstar, Montana, Venture). NO Aerostars, Astros or Safaris.
2. NO trucks, convertibles, jeeps, hearses, limousines or checker cabs.
3. Minivans previously run in demos may be considered too battered and unsafe, resulting in disqualification.

RUNNING

- a. Risk: Demolition derbies are hazardous and high-risk sports; therefore, anyone with a health condition, i.e., concussion, heart problems etc. or who is pregnant should not compete.
b. Disqualification: 1. Open Door 2. Fires 3. Unsafe vehicle 4. Non-working fire extinguisher 5. Special situation deemed necessary by official.
c. Personal Protective Equipment (PPE): Flame retardant racing apparel highly recommended. Racing suit, racing or work boots, neck brace, and gloves. Sport padding can also be used in addition to protective apparel. NO EXPOSED SKIN
d. Motor Sports helmets are mandatory – with most recent safety certification recommended. Goggles or face shields should be used.
e. Working Driver's seatbelt is mandatory.
f. BRAKES – VEHICLES MUST HAVE DEPENDABLE BRAKES AND MUST BE WORKING PROPERLY BEFORE ENTERING PEN AT ALL TIMES. All boundaries must be observed
g. NO DRINKING OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ON TRACK, EMERGENCY VEHICLE AREA OR IN THE PIT AREA. Any driver or pit person under the influence of alcohol or drugs will be immediately disqualified and removed from the grounds. This will be strictly enforced.
h. Competitive aggressive hits! Sandbaggers will be disqualified!
i. All cars are to be removed from the fairgrounds or racetrack immediately following the show.
j. Additional safety regulations may be imposed, depending on track and conditions.
k. ALL DECISIONS OF THE OFFICIAL ARE FINAL.

NO CHANGES OR ALTERATIONS OF RULES MAY BE MADE EXCEPT BY THRILL SHOW PRODUCTIONS INC. NO REFUNDS. NO CARS LEFT FOR JUNK!!!

PREPARATION OF CAR – REMOVE OR CONVERT THE FOLLOWING PRIOR TO ARRIVING AT FAIRGROUNDS OR TRACK

1. RIDING ON CAR	Insurance Regulation: No person riding on outside of cars at anytime
2. FLAMMABLE MATERIAL	Seats & trim - All must be removed from the vehicle except driver's seat. Dashboard may be left in.
3. TRAILER HITCH	Must be removed.
4. GLASS/AIRBAGS	All windows, mirrors, airbags & trim, must be removed prior to derby event.
5. DOORS & NUMBERS	Driver's door must be painted white. An optional roof number plate may be securely installed. NO painting of number on doors unless number registered with TSPI office. (see website for details).
6. FIRE EXTINGUISHER	Must be within reach of the driver, must work and have a working gauge.
7. BATTERY	One 12 volt car battery must be moved to front passenger floor board and securely fastened in a box/container clear of all fuel sources. Following inspection it must be covered with a non-flammable shield.
8. GAS TANK	Stock gas tanks must be removed. Must be a steel marine tank, custom steel fuel tank, or certified racing fuel cell. No plastic tanks. All tanks must be securely fastened down (bolted) behind the front seat and in the center of the passenger compartment. Tank must be covered with a non-flammable material after inspection. Maximum 3 gallons gas. Ref has final decision.
9. FUEL LINES	All fuel lines must have leak proof fitting with steel or rubber lines. No clear lines. No exceptions.
10. ELECTRIC FUEL PUMP	Must have a safety shut off switch (punch button), marked in red located on roof in center of the windshield area for officials use.
11. FUEL SYSTEM	Electric fuel pump must be isolated with a non-flammable material covering lines, tank & pump. Non-flammable covering may be fire resistant blanket or air bag material.
12. WELDING & ROLL BAR	A post to post bar may be welded into the driver's compartment for driver safety. It cannot be located anywhere other than behind the driver's seat, from the driver's side post to the passenger side post. (It may not be welded to the frame in any way) Motor mounts may be welded to the cross member. Excessive material use/welding will result in disqualification. Single roll bar up each doorframe, inside or across outside of the roof. Roll bars going across the roof must be through bolted twice through the roof for driver & spectator safety. This roll bar may be bolted to the frame or rockers. No excessive use of materials. Differential may be locked.
13. ENGINE	Must be stock year driveline. Fuel injected stays fuel injected and carbureted stays carbureted. Maximum 6 cylinder engine.
14. SHIFTERS	Shifters may be directly attached to transmission linkage & relocated to floor over transmission hump.
15. HOOD & TAILGATE	Openings: It is mandatory that an opening be cut in hood over carburetor, approximately 8" x 12" maximum in diameter. Strictly enforced. Recommend removing hood latch in case of fire. A hole should be cut in middle of trunk lid for visibility Fastening down: Hood, trunk or tailgate must be fastened down in 4 places with seat belt strapping, wire or ¼" chain only through each hole. Hood must be kept in original position and must be left open until after inspection. Tailgate must be in original position and fastened down in 4 places. Official's decision re: over-use of materials.
16. BODY PANELS	No body bending or bolting.
17. DOOR FASTENING	All doors must be fastened shut with wire, straps, ¼" chains or seat belts in 4 locations.
18. BRACING	Inside Car: NO cross bracing. Recommended - Back bracing post to post bar behind front seats - 2" to 4" in diameter - must be bolted. Outside Car: Driver door must be reinforced. Flat bar only, bolted 6 times (with a maximum ½" through bolt), or welded shut. e.g. Max. 60" long x 12" wide x ¼" thick. NO "C" CHANNEL, ANGLE IRON.
19. WINDSHIELD SPACE	Strong steel construction-type wire mesh is recommended for left front windshield only. Must have a minimum of a single steel bar or chain from the cowl to the roof, bolted. The "A" or "H" style protection is permissible but the bars must look like the A or H. The cross brace must be in the middle and in no way come in contact with the distributor protector. The horizontal bar must be a minimum 8" from cowl. If using the "A" it may be bolted in 3 locations. If using the "H" it may be bolted in 4 locations & be no more than 36" in width. Driver must not be impaired from exiting through window area of car in case of emergency.
20. FIRE WALL	All holes in firewall must be filled/covered with tin or nonflammable material.
21. BUMPERS	1. Only stock bumpers allowed. 2. No cutting of bumpers - may be bent inward. 3. Bumpers cannot be wired to hood. 4. No loading of bumpers (holes may be required to be cut in bumpers) - official's discretion.
22. RADIATOR	1. Radiators and cooling system must be flushed of anti-freeze and only water added. 2. Overflows for radiator must point downward to the ground. 3. Radiator must be in original position or removed.
23. TRANSMISSION COOLER	Are permitted and must be secured in engine compartment. Transmission dipstick must be securely fastened, wired down or have an overflow tube pointing straight down away from drivers or spectators.
24. LEAF SPRINGS SHOCKS & COILS	1. Suspension must be stock. 2. Movement must occur. 3. Coils may be wired to rear differential. 4. No welding. 5. No welding of steering parts. 6. No interchanging rear ends - stock only.
25. HEADERS	Must be secure, must point upwards and not at other drivers/spectators. Must be a reasonable length or will be asked to be cut or removed. Official's discretion.
26. FRAME ALTERATIONS	No patching, repairing or painting of frames.
27. ENGINE MOUNTS	Chained down engine mounts are recommended. Any excessive reinforcement will be disqualified.
28. BODY MOUNTS	Rubber body mounts must be kept in with stock size bolts. No extra bolts.
29. TIRES	Maximum 16" D.O.T. Tires must be low aggression. No forklift tires or solid fill tires. All tires must be filled with air only. Tires may be doubled. No split rims. No screwing tires to rim or studding. All wheel weights must be removed and no welding stem protections. Carry spare 16" D.O.T. mud tires in case track conditions warrant. Maximum ¼' between treads. Stock size rims only. Referee's discretion.
30. PRE-BENDING	No pre-bending.
